Timeline for Organizing a Book Drive

Step 1: Choose Your Date

Select a date for your book drive. This will help you plan and communicate effectively with participants.

Step 2: Customize Your Materials

Update the flyer template provided in the Book Kit with your organization's name, the date of your book drive, and any other relevant details.

Step 3: Set Up Donation Locations

Determine where you'll collect the donated books. Make sure the location is easily accessible for participants.

Step 4: Promote Your Book Drive

Share the event with your network, including employees, friends, family, and on social media. Use the example Facebook post and graphic from the Book Kit, or create your own. Be sure to tag us on social media:

Step 5: Collect Donations

Start gathering donated books. To engage participants, consider making it a friendly competition between departments or set a goal with a reward, like a pizza party, if it's achieved.
